Major Responsibilities:

- Create and maintain strong relationships with camp stakeholders including parents, campers, staff, prospective users and alumni
- Collaborate with Camping Services staff to ensure successful marketing and engagement plans are created and implemented. Utilize brand marketing tools to ensure strong enrollment and retention of campers
- Ensure staffing model meets camp enrollment needs and staff are hired based on excellence in performance
 Coach, train and ensure staff delivers consistent excellence in summer duties including in-person service and
- camper engagement. Utilize resources beyond internal camp staff to deepen the training program
 Develop staff training and staff expectations centered on kid-focused programming throughout all aspects of
- Develop start training and start expectations centered on kid-locused programming throughout an aspects of the summer program that implement the Vision and Values of the YMCA and Camp Minikani
- Ensure successful summer and winter camp programs by coordinating and implementing all details and logistics of both programs
- Understand and implement the corrective action process with staff not meeting policies and procedures
- Lead the administration of retention events and outreach meetings, including Camp for Kids
- Review parent and camper evaluations from the summer camp program and institute changes as needed. Report to the Program Committee of the Board of Managers on updates, trends and changes
- Work within budgeted guidelines for revenue and expense and ensure appropriate enrollments to meet revenue goals. Solicit feedback from seasonal staff in order to appropriately supply skill areas
- Ensure that summer camping programs meet all ACA, ACCT, State, Health Department and YMCA guidelines
- Responsible for ensuring that Camp Minikani maintains is American Camping Association accreditation.
- Assist with group facilitation and school group programs as needed
- Year-round oversight and management of Leadership Training program.
- Required to live on site at Camp Minikani from May 15 September 1 each year. Room and board provided during this time
- Accountable to the Minikani Operations Executive for execution of policies and procedures of the Association

Qualifications:

- A four year degree in education, recreation or a related field is required
- Minimum of 2-3 years of proven success in the summer camp setting
- Should have a positive history of leadership in the areas of staff development, relationship building and program management
- Proven ability to establish and maintain favorable relationships with people of diverse backgrounds required
- Current certifications in CPR, First Aid, Lifeguarding, and Challenge Course Inspector certifications are preferred
- Valid driver's license required
