Major Responsibilities:

- Develop, market, manage and implement all phases of the Miracle League Program. This part of the role will require direct participation in all evening and weekend programming during the season.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills required, speaking politely, clearly and articulating accurate information
- Train all volunteers prior to the start of each season
- Create team rosters and assign buddy match ups
- Work alongside Product Director in processing player registrations and volunteer paperwork
- Track and log weekly volunteer hours
- Must be comfortable advocating on behalf of people with disabilities, including establishing strong local partnerships with organizations who could help promote the program.
- Support the Product Director in fundraising efforts, including potential targeted, fundraising events.
- Serve as an on-site resource contact for the facilitation of youth and adult league programming, group outings and community events and gatherings.
- Assist with Miracle League of Milwaukee advisory committee meetings as able.
- Respond to all participant, collaborative partner, volunteer and community inquiries in a timely manner.
- Maintain a safe and encouraging environment at all times
- Prepare field and concessions stand for game day operations
- Basic computer skills needed
- Strictly adhere to all policies and procedures related to safety and conduct rules and other regulations.

Qualifications:

- A minimum of 2-3 years college coursework in the area of youth development or equivalent education/experience is required.
- A minimum of 1-2 years leadership experience in youth development.
- Requirements: CPR Pro/AED/02/FA and Emergency Action Plan training.
- Proficient in verbal and written communications.
- Should have a positive history of leadership in the areas of staff, volunteer and program development.
- Working knowledge and understanding of special needs populations is required.
