The YMCA Black Achiever's program is delighted that you have expressed an interest in participating in the upcoming tour. The annual tour provides an opportunity for high school students to be exposed to Historically Black Colleges & Universities throughout the country with the hopes of peaking your interest for future enrollment. The tour is geared toward students in 9th-11th grade. Consideration will be made for seniors who plan to attend any of the schools the tour will visit in 2016.

The Black College Tour process consists of 4 steps which include the following: 1) **Complete** Application Submission, 2) **Black College Tour Interview,** 3) Tour Acceptance/ Denial, 4) **Mandatory Pre- Tour Activities** (Orientation, Tour Retreat, Harley Davidson Sponsored Tour Breakfast, and Tour Send Off).

Please note that the YMCA staff in partnership with the Harley- Davidson motor company volunteers reserve the right to reject any application that does not meet the tour requirements. Tour requirements include the following:

- Minimum 2.5 cumulative G.P.A for Teen Achievers; 2.75 cumulative G.P.A for Non-Teen Achievers
- Complete application (letters of recommendation, report card showing cumulative G.P.A, essay question typed in a word document, application fee)
- Past Tour conduct/behavior
- Overall program conduct
- Program participation
- Feedback from references

Any applications received that are incomplete will not be accepted. Completed means that every necessary document requested is submitted at the same time.

ELIGIBILITY

The YMCA Black College Tour is open to all high school students grade 9th through 12th who meet the following criteria:

Minimum of 2.5 Cumulative G.P.A for Teen Achievers

Minimum of 2.75 Cumulative G.P.A for Non-Teen Achievers

Exhibits maturity, respect, and interest in pursuing a college education (determined by interview).

APPLICATION PROCESS

All candidates must COMPLETE the application form and submit the following:

\$25 Teen Achiever Application Fee-Teen Achievers only (non-refundable)

\$50 Non Teen Achiever Application Fee

Most recent report card

2 recommendation forms, completed by a teacher, counselor, mentor, pastor, or Teen Advisor that is NOT a relative.

A 750 (max) word 5 paragraph typed essay that answers the following questions: It has been 10 years since Hurricane Katrina devastated the Southeast. What are lessons you learned from Hurricane Katrina's devastation and the public response? How can these lessons help prepare you for college? Explain why this makes you a good candidate for the 2016 tour.

Complete Applications will be accepted until 12/1/2015 5:00 p.m. Applications received after that date will be wait listed.

Once you submit your COMPLETE application with all items by the deadline, you will be contacted to schedule your interview. If all application items are not received, no interview will be granted. After acceptance, a \$100 deposit is due within 2 weeks. Failure to pay the deposit within the 2 weeks will result in a \$25 late fee. It is important that you turn in your application as soon as possible.

TOUR COST: \$450 for Teen Achiever Program Participants/ \$550 for Community Participants

All applications received after 12/1 will be wait listed. Students will be contacted based on their COMPLETE application and available space.
