- Guide Kid Zone staff in providing a daily curriculum that is cognizant of children's developmental needs.
- Responsible for overseeing all aspects of the Kid Zone department. Ensure the safety and wellbeing of Kid Zone staff and children under their supervision.
- Ensure adequate staffing of Kid Zone by maintaining a sufficient ratio of qualified staff by creating the department schedule. Directly supervise Kid Zone Staff and volunteers in accordance with Association and Branch policies.
- Develop and promote YMCA programs as they relate to children and the department.
- Develop and implement an active staff development plan for Kid Zone staff through formal and informal means, utilizing meetings, conversations, workshops and examples.
- Communicate, connect and build relationships with participants and families: respond to inquiries and/or concerns in a timely fashion.
- Provide immediate first aid and CPR as necessary and develop and/or review the YMCA emergency plan with Kid Zone staff.
- Effectively communicate with supervisor regarding concerns including, but not limited to, member behavior issues and staff behavior issues.
- Complete all other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- A minimum of 1-2 years college coursework in the area of youth development or equivalent education/experience is required.
- Previous supervisory experience is preferred.
- Must be able to successfully complete CPR PRO/AED/O2/FA within 3 months of hire.
