Responsibilities:

- Responsible for supervision, training and evaluation of all equestrian staff. Assists in staff training, oversight of equestrian summer staff and program, and ensures that safe horseback riding disciplines are practiced by staff.
- On a daily basis, identifies, minimizes and eliminates, where possible, any perceived risks that could endanger staff, participants or horses. Interpret safety and health standards to program area and follow through with their compliance.
- Responsible for strict adherence to all policies and procedures related to safety and conduct rules and other regulations.
- Plan, direct, and supervise a safe, fun and meaningful horseback riding program that meets camp goals including; writing lesson plans, evaluating riding ability, setting daily staff and session schedules, and delivering riding activities.
- Ability to manage using creativity, initiative, and flexibility to ensure program standards, outcomes and member satisfaction is consistently achieved.
- Manage the physical facilities, equipment and safety and health of horses in the equestrian riding
 program area including but not limited to: setting up riding arena, teaching proper use of equipment,
 ensuring horses are right for the program, conducting inventory, ordering and moving hay, evaluating
 horses for health needs and behavior issues, record keeping and submitting orders for equipment and
 supplies when needed.
- Manage all enrollment and revenue goals and monitor expenses to operate within annual budgeted amounts.
- Manage and ensure safety and health of the horse herd included leased horses, owned and boarded horses. Also responsible for the health of any other animal on property.
- Participate as a member of the camp management team and enthusiastically plan, direct, and supervise evening programs, special events, overnights, and other all-camp activities and camp functions in order to promote Camp Minikani, the Equestrian Program and the mission of the Y.
- Responsible for the duties of this job, as well as others that may be assigned by camp management **Oualifications:**

High School Diploma, and at least 3 years' experience in an equestrian field; including equestrian certifications at least 21 years old

- Must be passionate and have prior experience in leading and communicating program goals, progress and outcomes as well as program planning and promoting
