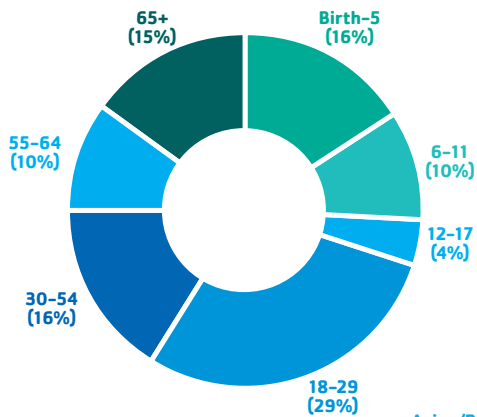

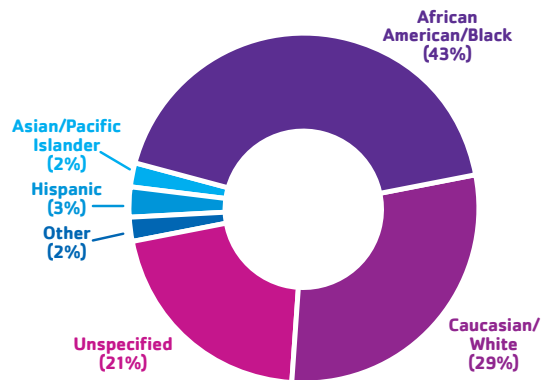

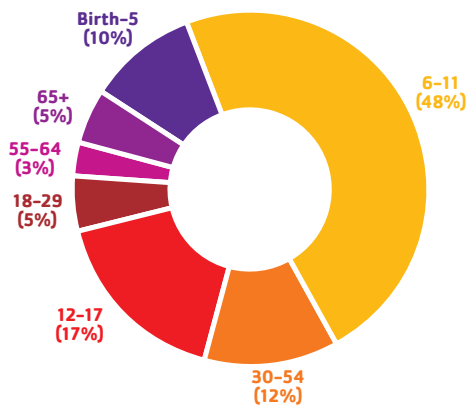
MEMBERSHIP BY AGE

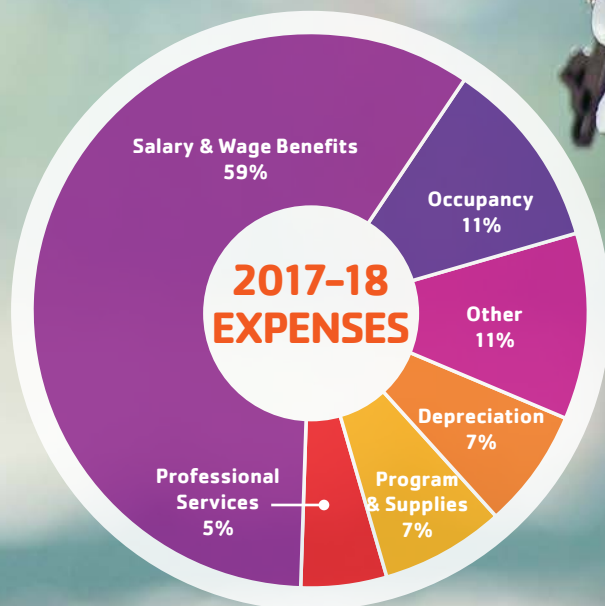
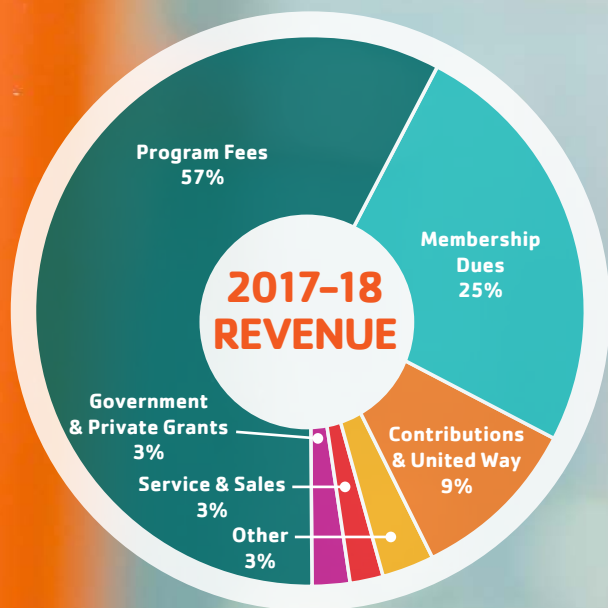

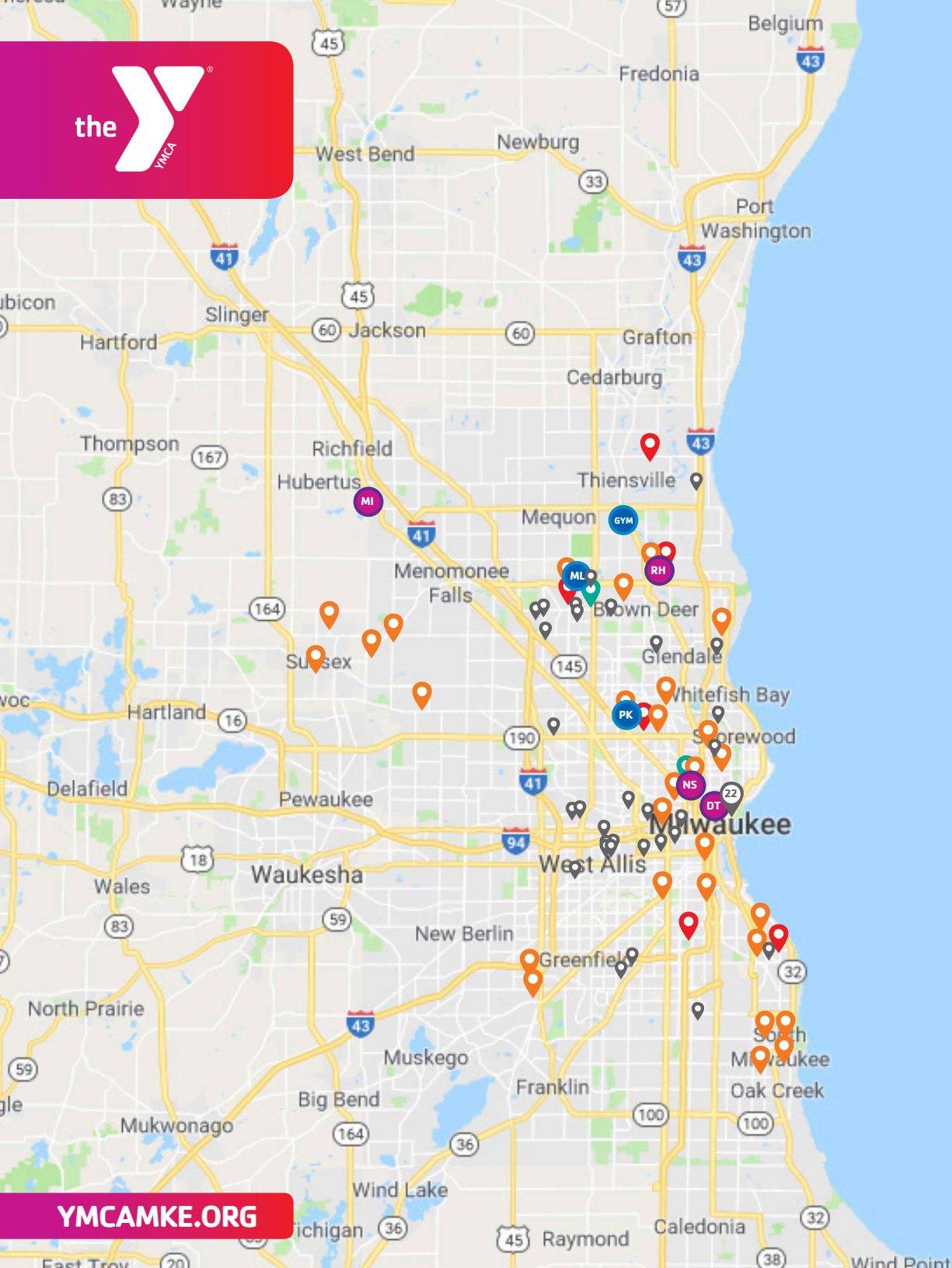
