GLOSSARY OF TERMS

- Virtual Branch Meetings:** Meet twice a month (see schedule for specific days). Teens at the respective branches will receive information regarding program updates, careers, college planning, leadership, character, and community service.
- Teen Summit:** One day of virtual workshops on various topics that will help teens prepare for a successful future. Topics include leadership and professional development, character, resume writing, and financial literacy. Mandatory event for Teen Achievers. A fee between \$25.00 - \$40.00 is assessed to each teen.
- Virtual Black College Tour:** Three-day virtual tour meeting with designated Historically Black Colleges and Universities. This will include an icebreaker activity, Q&A with college panels, financial aid workshop, and virtual campus tours. Information on historical sites will be shared during this time. Student participation is open to all high school students. A \$25 application fee will be assessed.
- World of Work (WOW) Workshops:** Hosted the 4th Thursday of the month. Teens will participate in virtual career exploration workshops, which are hosted by sponsoring area corporations.
- Linkage:** Comprised of teen executive board President and Vice Presidents for each location. This group meets with the adult advisors to plan agendas and activities for the center meetings. Linkage meets once a month.
- EOY- End of Year Celebration:** Time in which the teens are acknowledged for their work in the program. Seniors are highlighted and scholarships for eligible students are distributed. Seniors will also announce the Universities they will be attending.
- Leadership Retreat:** Student leaders voted to represent their centers will participate in a day of leadership readiness workshops.
- Kwanza Celebration:** A celebration of life, paying homage to African American culture. Teens, parents, adult volunteers, and staff join in festivity, which usually involves student presentations, singing, dancing, and sharing of ethnic cuisine/recipes.
- Hispanic Heritage Appreciation:** Recognition for the contributions and influence of Hispanic Americans to the history, culture, and achievements of the United States.
- In State Tours:** Will host three virtual tours with local colleges/universities, that include an icebreaker activity, Q&A with college panels, and virtual campus tours. A \$25 application fee will be assessed. (Application fee covers all three virtual tours)
