- Creation of the online class will only occur after the minimum class registration number has been met.
- Minimally the online training link will be sent 72 hours prior to in person skill session.
 - If the minimum class number is not met the class will **NOT** run.
 - Registered participants will receive notification of the class cancellation 72 hours prior to the in-person skill session.
 - Students should not attend and reschedule their in-person session if they answer yes to any of the following questions:
 - In the Last 14 days have you:
 - Been told by a public health official that you may have been exposed to coronavirus (Covid-19)?
 - Been in direct contact with a known coronavirus (COVID-19) case while not using PPE?
 - Returned from international travel?
- The online portion of the course will take approximately 4 hours to complete.
- Online training links will be sent by both American Health & Safety Institute as well as zhutchens@ymcamke.org.
- Online Training **MUST** be completed prior to the in-person skill session.
- To assist with social distancing if you have not completed the online training 1 hour prior to the course start you will be contacted via phone/text message to inform you that you are ineligible to attend the in-person skill session.
- *Currently only Blended Learning Combination Classes are available. Recertification Classes and Stand-alone CPR/AED, Basic Life Support, or First Aid Classes are not being offered.*
